

## 35<sup>th</sup> INTERNATIONAL RALLY OF THE VESPA HISTORICAL REGISTER

## - ROMA IUBILAEUM 2025-

## **SEPTEMBER 5 - 7, 2025**

The 35th International Rally of the Vespa Historical Register - ROMA IUBILAEUM 2025 - will be held in Rome from Friday, September 5 to Sunday, September 7, 2025, under the sponsorship of the Vespa Historical Register, the Vespa Club of Italy, and the Vespa World Club. It will be organized by the Vespa nel Tempo Club of Rome on the occasion of the XXV Universal Jubilee, which is celebrated every 25 years.

The event aims to protect and promote the preservation of vintage Vespa, placing the historical sector related to the Vespa world at the center of the international stage.

The choice of Rome - the capital of Italy - should represent a source of pride for all Vespa enthusiasts, as the Vespa is a symbol of Italian craftsmanship worldwide and is destined to be recognized as Italian Cultural Heritage.

The Vespa Village will be set up in a prestigious location from which all visits and excursions will be planned.

Approximately 100 vintage Vespa (admitted until the year 1976) will participate in the event, totaling about 200 people, including riders, passengers, and special guests.

The program, still in the planning stages, foresees the start of the event on the afternoon of Friday, September 5, with registration and the delivery of the welcome kit followed by a parade through the streets of Rome and an evening cocktail dinner with musical entertainment.

On Saturday morning, on the occasion of the XXV Universal Jubilee, guided tours on Vespa will visit the Holy Doors of the Jubilee 2025: the Basilica of Santa Maria Maggiore, the Basilica of San Giovanni, and the Basilica of San Paolo, followed by a brunch on a terrace overlooking the Tiber River.

The Elegance Contest - the true core of the event - will begin in the early afternoon and will be divided into categories: Historical (for vehicles built from 1946 to 1956) and Vintage (for vehicles built from 1957 to 1976).

The awards ceremony will take place in the evening, preceded by a gala dinner.

But it's not over: at 11 p.m., escorted by the Motorcycle Section of the Carabinieri, a Rome by Night tour will start, retracing the routes of the famous film 'Roman Holiday'.

On Sunday morning - again escorted by the Motorcycle Section of the Carabinieri - the parade will head to St. Peter's Square, where the last Holy Door will be crossed and the Angelus and Papal blessing will be attended.

A quick lunch at the Vespa Village will mark the time for greetings and the conclusion of the 35th International Rally of the Vespa Historical Register-**ROMA IUBILAEUM 2025.**
